



SINGH BRAR EYES MORE FALDO SERIES SUCCESS AT MOORTOWN

2012 CHAMPION LEADS BY ONE GOING IN TO THE FINAL ROUND

8 April 2014: Jack Singh-Brar of Remedy will take a slender one shot lead in to the final round of the Faldo Series England North Championship. The 17-year-old, who won the Faldo Series Grand Final in 2012, added a 72 to an opening day 73 in blustery conditions at Moortown Golf Club in Leeds.

Overnight co-leader Oliver Clarke (Formby) is Singh Brar's nearest challenger for the overall title on four-over after shooting a 75 in the second round. Ben Brewster (Bawtry) and Oliver White (Pannal) are a shot further back from Clarke and one ahead of a group of four players on six-over which includes Matty Lamb from Hexham and Windermere's Adam Chapman. Berkhamsted's Alice Hewson leads the Girls' Division by three after a superb one-under par 74 took her back to plus two for the tournament.

Golfers aged 12 to 21 are competing over three rounds at Moortown Golf Club in Leeds for the 2014 England North Championship. The field is divided into four age-groups - three for boys and one for girls - and the winners of each division plus the girls' runner-up will join Sir Nick Faldo at the season-ending 18th Faldo Series Grand Final at The Greenbrier in West Virginia, USA.

Supported by The R&A, ISPS Handa, The European Tour and The Greenbrier the 2014 Faldo Series Europe schedule features 17 tournaments in 15 countries including three in England plus others in Abu Dhabi, Ireland, Chile, Wales, Brazil, Scotland, Czech Republic, Italy, Austria, Netherlands, Germany, Poland, Slovakia and the USA.

Established in 1996, 40 Faldo Series tournaments now take place in 30 countries worldwide with more than 7,000 golfers participating each year. Past winners include Major Champions Rory McIlroy and Yani Tseng.
